- Repair and fault trace to electrical component level is desirable.
- Knowledge and experience of analogue and digital fault finding is desirable.

You should be competent with wiring control panels including wiring to components as well as being able to produce wiring looms and cable forms to a high standard. A knowledge of manufacturing and fault tracing of surface mount PCB's as well as through hole PCB's is desirable.

Experience within industrial X-Ray and or the NDT industry would be a distinct advantage.

You should possess good communication skills to facilitate efficient communication within the team.

Experience of working within a production role in the electronic industry to a quality management system (ISO9001) would be advantageous. During all aspects of your work, you will be required to ensure the companies adherence to this standard.

You should be a self-motivated individual who has a patient "can do" attitude and takes pride in their work.
